

# West County Elementary Summer School

May 25th -June 18th 8:00am-3:00pm

## K & 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Program

Kindergarten and first grade students will receive instruction in reading, language arts, science, technology, engineering and math or STEM. There will be many fun hands on activities!

## 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Program

Each grade level will participate in a variety of activities in the form of clubs. One club per day will be literacy based. The other three involve science, technology, engineering and math or STEM. All clubs will incorporate hands on activities.

## BREAKFAST/LUNCH PROGRAM

Through the Department of Health and Senior Services Summer School Food Program, breakfast & lunches will be available to all children at no cost. Breakfast will be available from 7:30-8:30. Lunch is scheduled from 10:30-12:30pm. Lunches are provided for field trips as well. A menu will be sent home on the first day of summer school.

## GRADES

Students attending mandatory summer school will be assessed at the end of the summer program and parents will be notified if sufficient progress has been made for promotion.

## STUDENT CONDUCT

Respectful and responsible conduct will be expected from each student who enrolls in the summer program. Students with poor conduct will not be allowed to attend fun days, field trips and may be suspended from summer school.

## TRANSPORTATION

Buses will run each morning and afternoon to pick up & drop off points. Students should be at the pickup point by 7:25 am on the first day. As summer progresses, bus routes will become more efficient and will settle into a more consistent pickup time. Walkers and pickups will be dismissed at 2:50. All others will load the buses at 2:55. If you are picking up a student, please arrive before 2:55.

## FUN DAYS/FIELD TRIPS

Students who have good attendance and good behavior will be able to attend a Fun day and/or field trip. A permission form will be sent home the first week of summer school. The permission slip must be signed and returned or your child will not be allowed to attend.
